DECISION

- 1 Martin King, the patent proprietor and inventor, filed an application in accordance with rule 10(2) of the Patents Rules 2007 to the effect that Andrew Craig should be mentioned as a joint inventor.
- 2 Martin King and Andrew Craig filed written consent in support of the application. As such the application is treated as unopposed. I therefore conclude that Andrew Craig should be named as a joint inventor, along with Martin King.
- 3 Accordingly, I find that Andrew Craig should be mentioned as a joint inventor in the published patent application and granted patent for the invention. I therefore direct, in accordance with rule 10(1), that an addendum slip mentioning Andrew Craig as a joint inventor be prepared for the published patent application and granted patent for the invention.
