And I do hereby further certify and attest that of the consideration a sum of Rupees Eight hundred and Seventy (Rs. 870) was set off for the amount due to the vendee on Bond No. 230 of 22nd November, 1918, and the balance sum of Rupees Four thousand Six hundred and Thirty (Rs. 4,630) was paid in my presence and that before the same was read over as aforesaid, that in page 1, in line 15 of duplicate the letter "w" in word Malwattengewatta was written over an erasure and in line 16 the letter "a" was written more clearly and that the original of this Instrument bears a stamp of the value of one rupee and that the duplicate of this instrument bears five stamps of the value of Rs. 87 and that the said stamps were supplied by me.
