POST MORTEM FINDINGS:

Body of a well nourished Chinese female adult clad only in a blue striped Chinese blouse. There are five button spaces on the blouse but only the top one remains as a half button, the rest were torn away from their spaces with bare threads showing. No other tears present on the blouse. The finger nails are short. Rigor mortis had completely resolved but there is no evidence of decomposition as yet. Death had occurred about 30 to 36 hours before the post-mortem, i.e. around midnight on 22.4.72. Body height 150 cms. Body weight 56,300 gms.

EXTERNAL INJURIES:

- (1) Multiple bruises over the whole forehead with small abrasions on the left side.
- (2) Multiple small bruises over the bridge of nose with small abrasions.
- (3) Haemorrhages in both eyes especially on the right side with bruise around the right eye.
- (4) Multiple small bruises and abrasions on the lower lip and chin with laceration on the right corner of lower lip.
- (5) Bruises on left chin.
- (6) A small irregular laceration 0.5 cm long on the left side of lower neck. Further down the left side of the lower neck another similar laceration.
- (7) Small bruises on lobe of left ear.
- (8) Right face appears swollen as compared with left face.
- (9) Extensive bruising on the radial side of right wrist 7 x 5 cms and back of right hand at base of index finger.
- (10) Multiple abrasions and bruises along left forearm wrist and back of left hand.
- (11) Bruise and abrasions on left hip with some linear scratches.
- (12) A group of three rounded bruises about 1 cm in diameter on the inner side of right knee consistent with finger tip marks.
- (13) Another group of 4 similar bruises on the inner side of left knee.
- (14) Right knee shows abraded skin with no vital reactions indicating injury made after death.
- (15) Left knee shows similar abraded skin without vital reactions.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION:

EXTERNAL SYSTEM:

Skull - no fractures. But there is extensive bruising of the scalp on the forehead.

Ribs - fracture of left 2nd to 5th ribs and right 2nd to 6th ribs at mid-clavicular line anteriorly on both sides with bruising of pleura beneath. The injury suggests compression on the front of chest. No free blood in the chest cavities.

GENERAL NERVOUS SYSTEM:

Brain: 1205 gms. Congested. No evidence of haemorrhage.

Neck region: Dissected in a bloodless field shows haemorrhage at the right chin. Laryngeal mucosa very congested. Hyoid bone and thyroid cartilages intact.

CARDIO VASCULAR SYSTEM:

Heart: 266 gms. Normal. Valves and vessels normal.

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM:

Trachea and bronchi normal.

Lungs: right 485 gms, left 400 gms. Both lungs are congested but not oedematous. No excessive fluid.

ALIMENTARY SYSTEM:

Stomach - empty. No fluid but only small remnants of rice.

Intestines - normal.

Liver: 1297 gms. Congested.

GENITOURINARY SYSTEM:

Spleen: 94 gms. Congested.

GENITO-URINARY SYSTEM:

Uterus: right 80 gms, left 80 gms. Congested.

Uterus and ovaries atrophied. There are two small abrasions on the right side of the vaginal wall near the orifice. Some whitish discharge present. Vaginal smears did not reveal any spermatozoa but diatomaceous material present.

The accused Mohd. Yasin who is brought before me by Inspector Michael Won is now left alone with me and my sworn interpreter Mr. Said bin Siswo in the chambers of the 9th Magistrate's Court. The time is now 10.06 p.m. 11th February, 1973. I inform accused I am a Magistrate.

- Q. What Language do you usually speak?
A. Malay.
- Q. In what language do you wish to speak now?
A. Malay.
- Q. Have you been examined by a Medical Officer before you were brought here?
A. Yes.
- Q. At what time were you examined?
A. I cannot remember the time.

(I also inspect Medical report produced earlier by Inspector Michael Won).

- Q. What is your name?
A. Mohamed Yassin bin Husin. I am also known as Rosli.
- Q. What is your race?
A. Malay.
- Q. What is your address?
A. I forgot.
- Q. What is your occupation?
A. Stevedore at Changi Jetty.
- Q. What is your age?
A. 20 years.
- Q. On what charge have you been arrested?
A. On the death of a woman at Pulau Ubin.
- Q. When were you arrested?
A. Yesterday i.e. 10th February, 1973 at about 12.15 p.m.
- Q. Where were you arrested?
A. At Changi jetty.
- Q. Who arrested you?
A. A police detective and another person.
- Q. In whose custody have you been since then?
A. C.I.D.

- Q. Where have you been confined?
- A. At the C.I.D.
- Q. How long have you been confined?

Q. What is it you want to say?

A. I came here to admit that I was wrong.

I had a meeting with 2 other friends. Harun and Maarof. The discussion centred around going to a female Chinese's house. It was Harun who asked Maarof whether he wanted to go. Maarof did not want to. When he asked me I told him I wanted to. I went to fetch a sampan at about 7.30 p.m. Harun and I then went to the house of the female Chinese. The female Chinese was about to sleep when we arrived. Harun and I circled the house. The female Chinese was silent and the lights were being dimmed.

Harun and I then looked for a spot from where we could climb into the house. There was no entrance where I could enter. So I went to disturb the chickens at the chicken coop. The chickens made a lot of noise which woke up the female Chinese who came out with a small light.

Immediately when she opened the door, Harun jumped at her. The female Chinese at this stage shouted but her voice was faint. Harun grabbed the female Chinese after which he asked me to grab hold of this woman. When I took over and grabbed this woman, Harun entered to the room. When I grabbed the woman she put up a fight. I had no intention of killing her. I just hit her. Whilst I was warding off her attacks, her trousers accidentally slipped off. When I saw this my desire was aroused. I then wanted to have sexual intercourse with her. Before I could start to play her she gave a blow at me. I warded it off. When my penis penetrated into her vagina she suddenly fell silent.

After I had played her I pulled out my penis. The female Chinese was still quiet. Whilst I was doing all these Harun was ransacking the room. When Harun came out of the room he found nothing inside it. He then asked me to carry the woman into the sampan. After putting the body into the sampan we left the shore. I was rowing the sampan. Halfway across Harun suggested that we throw the woman into the sea. After doing so i.e. throwing the woman into the sea, I went back to the jetty.

From the jetty Harun and I went to Bedok for some food. After having some food Harun asked me to follow him to Desker Road. He wanted to give me a treat. There I played another woman i.e. had sexual intercourse.

From Desker Road Harun asked me to go back to Changi. Then I went back to the motor-boat where I slept.

Q. Is that all you wish to say?

A. Yes.

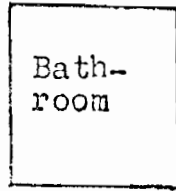

MEMORANDUM OF ENQUIRY

The Accused who is brought to me by Inspector Michael Won of C.I.D. is now left alone with me and my sworn interpreter (Mr. Ishak b. Hj. Nawawi) in a separate room at Magistrate's Court No.3.

The time is now 12.29 p.m. date 16th February, 1973.

Q. What language do you usually speak?

A. I speak Malay.

Q. In what language do you wish to speak now?

A. I wish to speak Malay now.

I inform the Accused that I am a Magistrate.

Accused says: Yes.

Q. Have you been examined by a Medical Officer before you are brought here?

A. Yes.

Q. At what time were you examined?

A. That I don't know.

Q. Can you say how long ago was this?

A. I was medically examined just now. On that day I was also medically examined.

(At this stage, I inspected a medical examination form NP 306 dated 10th February 1973 bearing the signature of Dr. B.G. Law - the Medical Officer i/c of Maxwell Road Outpatient Dispensary. I initialled on this document. This was handed to me by Inspector Michael Won earlier).

I requested the Accused to remove his clothes. I explained to him that this was for me to ascertain whether he has any external injuries. The Accused has no objections, and proceeded to remove his shirt and not his pair of trousers as he has no underwear.

I noticed a cut on the front of his chest.

Q. How did you sustain this?

A. I was kicked in the C.I.D. lock-up.

Q. When did this happen?

A. About 2 days ago when I was detained in the lock-up. It was on the second day when I was detained in the lock-up.

Q. Do you know who kicked you in respect of the cut?

A. I don't know the person.

Q. Do you know why you were kicked?

A. They or he were angry. Two persons assaulted me. They were angry.

Q. What is your name?

A. My name is Mohamed Yasin bin Hussein.

Q. What is your race?

A. I am a Malay.

Q. What is your address?

A. I can't remember my address.

Q. What is your occupation?

A. I am a labourer.

Q. What is your age?

A. I am 19 years plus now.

Q. On what charge have you been arrested?

A. That I murdered someone.

Q. When were you arrested?

A. It was one Saturday - last Saturday.

Q. Where were you arrested?

A. At Changi jetty whilst I was on board a motor-boat.

Q. Who arrested you?

A. A C.I.D. personnel. I was arrested by 4 C.I.D. personnel. Two came on board the motor boat and other remained at the jetty.

Q. In whose custody have you been since then?

A. I was in the custody of the C.I.D.

Q. Where have you been confined?

A. In the lock-up at C.I.D. premises.

Q. Why do you come here?

A. I want to say about myself.

I caution Accused that he is not obliged to make any statement to me if he does not wish to do so, but if he made any statement such statement may be used as evidence at his trial.

Q. Do you understand this caution which I have just administered to you?

A. Yes, I understand.

Q. Do you still wish to make a statement?

A. Yes.

Q. When did you decide to make such a statement?

A. Two days ago when I was still in the lock-up, I decided to make a statement.

Q. In order to make you decide to make this statement has any police officer or person in authority made any inducement?

A. No. It is on my own.

Q. In order to make you decide to make this statement has any police officer or person in authority made any threat?

A. No threat was used by any one.

Q. In order to make you decide to make this statement has any police officer or person in authority made any promise?

A. No. It was all on my own.

Q. Has any police officer or person in authority assaulted you or otherwise compelled you to make a statement?

A. No.

Q. You decided to make a statement despite being assaulted by someone in the C.I.D.

A. If I don't want to make a statement, will that be alright. Must I make a statement.

At this stage I re-administered the caution to the Accused.

I cautioned him again that he is not obliged to make any statement to me if he does not wish to do so, but if he made any statement such statement may be used as evidence at his trial.

Q. Do you understand this caution which I have just administered to you again?

A. Yes.

Q. Do you still wish to make a statement?

A. Yes.

Q. You wish to make a statement, inspite of being assaulted by someone at the C.I.D. on your chest which resulted in an injury?

A. I don't wish to make a statement.

From this inquiry, I am not satisfied that the Accused is about to make a statement voluntarily.
