**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A21 Trunk Road (Quarry Hill Interchange – Pembury Road Interchange, Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - *2nd August 2010*

*Coming into force* - - *7th August 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A21 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road and on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed on and near the road:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A21 Trunk Road (Quarry Hill Interchange - Pembury Interchange, Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 7th August 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A21 Trunk Road near Tonbridge in the County of Kent;

“the length of southbound carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between Quarry Hill Interchange (A26) and Pembury Road Interchange (A264/A228);

“the slip road” means the road leading from the A2014 to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Vauxhall Lane junction;

“works” mean tree cutting work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Sunday 8th August 2010 or on any subsequent day until 6th February 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of southbound carriageway or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

(a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

(b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of southbound carriageway or the slip road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that carriageway or that slip road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
