**The A46 Trunk Road (Beckford to Sedgeberrow,
Worcestershire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour and 40 Miles
Per Hour Speed Restriction) (No. 2) Order 2010**

Made - - - - *09 August 2010*
Coming into force - - *16 August 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Beckford and Sedgeberrow in the County of Worcestershire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Beckford to Sedgeberrow, Worcestershire) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) (No. 2) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 16 August 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A46 from its junction with Station Road, Beckford to its junction with Sandfield Lane, Sedgeberrow;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Thursday 19 August 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding -

(a) 10 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

(b) 40 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst such traffic signs in relation to those lengths are not displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
