**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M5 Motorway (Junction 10 Northbound Entry Slip Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - *31 August 2010*

*Coming into force* - - *3 September 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway (“the M5”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads at Junction 10 in the County of Gloucestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 10 Northbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 3 September 2010.

**2.** In this Order –

“the slip road” means the northbound entry slip road at M5 Junction 10;

“the works” mean pavement investigation works;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 6 September 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
