**The A52 Trunk Road (Queens Drive Roundabout to Nottingham Knight Roundabout, Nottingham)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - 10 September 2010

Coming into force - - 17 September 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and three of those connecting roads, in the City of Nottingham and the County of Nottinghamshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Queens Drive Roundabout to Nottingham Knight Roundabout, Nottingham) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 17 September 2010.

2. In this Order:

“Queens Drive Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A52 at its roundabout junction with the A453 Queens Drive;

“Nottingham Knight Roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A52 at its roundabout junction with the A60 Loughborough Road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 2000 hours on Monday 20 September 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in –

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (a) the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its junction with the slip road leading from the B679 Clifton Lane to its junction with Nottingham Knight Roundabout;
 - (b) the eastbound carriageway of the A52 between its junction with the slip road leading to Queens Drive Roundabout and its junction with the slip road leading from Queens Drive Roundabout;
 - (c) the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from Queens Drive Roundabout;
 - (d) the slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the A52 to the westbound carriageway of the A453 Clifton Lane; and
 - (e) the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from the B679 Clifton Lane.
4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable,
 - (iii) being used in connection with the said works; or
 - (iv) proceeding in the A52 to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
