**The A21 Trunk Road (Tonbridge Bypass, Southbound
Carriageway) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction)
Order 2010**

Made - - - - *27th September 2010*

Coming into force - - *16th October 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A21 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A21 Trunk Road (Tonbridge Bypass, Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 16th October 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A21 Trunk Road near Tonbridge in the County of Kent;

“the southbound carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road (Tonbridge Bypass) between Barnetts Wood footbridge near Leigh and Lower Haysden Lane underbridge;

“works” mean embankment works on the trunk road; and

“the works period” means the period starting on Monday 18th October 2010 and ending on 15th April 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the southbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
