**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A49 Trunk Road (Hereford) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *27 September 2010*  
*Coming into force* - - - - - *04 October 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the City of Hereford should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Hereford) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 4 October 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means –

- (i) the A49, known as Edgar Street and Newtown Road, between a point 100 metres south and a point 100 metres north of its roundabout junction with the B4359 and Farriers Way, including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout; and
- (ii) the A49, known as Newtown Road and Holmer Road, between a point 100 metres south and a point 100 metres north of its roundabout junction with Priors Place, including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 11 October 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A49 at its junctions with –

- (a) Farriers Way;
- (b) Newtown Road; or
- (c) Priory Place

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

- (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or proceeding at the direction of or with the permission of a police constable; and
- (b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works;
