**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road and the M42 Motorway (M42 Junction 6)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made - - - - 11 October 2010*

*Coming into force - - 18 October 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), the M42 Motorway (“the M42”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of the A45 and five of those connecting roads in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road and the M42 Motorway (M42 Junction 6) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 18 October 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the roundabout” means the circulatory carriageway of the A45 at its junction with the M42 Junction 6;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading –

- (i) from the westbound carriageway of the A45 to the roundabout;
- (ii) from the southbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 6 to the roundabout;
- (iii) to the southbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 6 from the roundabout;
- (vi) from the northbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 6 to the roundabout; and
- (v) to the northbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 6 from the roundabout;

“the works period” means the period starting at 22.00 hours on Friday 22 October 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the roundabout or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
