ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A259 Trunk Road (Guestling Thorn – Guestling Green)
(Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2010**

Made - - - - *8th November 2010*

Coming into force - - *27th November 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Guestling Thorn – Guestling Green) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 27th November 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road (Winchelsea Road) near Hastings in the County of East Sussex;

“the first length of trunk road” means the trunk road between points 830 metres east of the centreline of North Lane at Guestling Thorn and 100 metres north of the property boundary of Minstead and Glen Rosa at Guestling Green;

“the second length of trunk road” means the trunk road between its junction with Butcher’s Lane and a point 100 metres north of the property boundary of Minstead and Glen Rosa;

“the third length of trunk road” means the trunk road between points 120 metres southwest of the property boundary between 1 and 2 Rose Cottages and 90 metres northeast of the centreline of Friars Hill at Guestling Green;

“works” mean resurfacing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 29th November 2010 or on any subsequent day until 26th May 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

(a) 10 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (b) 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road or the third length of trunk road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to those lengths of road are not displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
