ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road and the M6 and M69 Motorways (M6 Junction 2, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 8 November 2010

Coming into force - - 15 November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway (“the M6”), the M69 Motorway (“the M69”), the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those motorways, that trunk road and some of those connecting roads near Ansty in the County of Warwickshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road and the M6 and M69 Motorways (M6 Junction 2, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 15 November 2010.

2. In this Order:

| “the trunk road” | means the northbound carriageway of the A46 from its roundabout junction with the A428 to its junction with the M69; |
| “the motorway” | means the northbound carriageway of the M69 from its junctions with the A46 to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 1; |
| “the link road” | means the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2 to the northbound carriageway of the M69; |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 22 November 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road, on the motorway, or the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or a traffic officer in uniform; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
