ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Junction 35A to Junction 36) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - - 22 November 2010

Coming into force - - - - - 5 December 2010

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway and connecting roads, in the District of Barnsley in the County of South Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway resurfacing and traffic loop installation works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 35A to Junction 36) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 5 December 2010.

2. In this Order; –

“the M1” means the M1 Motorway;

“the northbound carriageway” and “the southbound carriageway” mean, respectively, the M1 northbound and southbound carriageways from a point 450 metres south of the centreline of the southbound entry slip road overbridge at Junction 35A (Stocksbridge) northwards for a distance of 3100 metres;

“a slip road” means the M1 northbound exit and southbound entry slip roads at Junction 36 (Tankersley);

“the works period” means a period of 10 hours commencing at 20:00 hours on Monday 6 December 2010 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound carriageway, the southbound carriageway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
