**The A49 Trunk Road (Greyfriars Bridge, Hereford) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - 20 December 2010

Coming into force - - 27 December 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road at Hereford in the District of the County of Herefordshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Greyfriars Bridge, Hereford) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 27 December 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the A49 between a point 250 metres north and a point 300 metres south of the centrepiece of Greyfriars Bridge, Hereford;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 3 January 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on a length of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in -

- (a) the northbound carriageway of the trunk road; or
- (b) the offside lane of the southbound carriageway of the trunk road in any direction other than northwards.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in -

- (a) the southbound carriageway of the trunk road; or
- (b) the offside lane of the northbound carriageway of the trunk road in any direction other than southwards.

7. Subject as mentioned in articles 8 and 9, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway adjacent to the trunk road.

8. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

9. The provisions of:

- (a) articles 3, 4, 5(a) and 6(a) shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (b) articles 5(a) and 6(a) shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works; and
- (c) article 7 shall not apply to any person –
 - (i) engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activity; or
 - (ii) engaged in activity connected with the works.
