**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham-by-Sea)
Regulations 2011**

Made - - - - - *25th March 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *20th August 2011*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Shoreham-by-Sea, West Sussex, by reason of the intended holding of a flying display that is scheduled to take place on 20th and 21st August 2011.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Shoreham-by-Sea) Regulations 2011 and come into force on 20th August 2011.

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1000 hours and 1600 hours on each of 20th and 21st August 2011, no aircraft is to fly below Flight Level 55 within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 3.5 nautical miles whose centre is at 505008N 0001750E.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the Air Traffic Control Unit at Shoreham Airport.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Shoreham-by-Sea, West Sussex, by reason of air displays that are scheduled to take place there on 20th and 21st August 2011. A large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the airshow. The Civil Aviation Authority's Directorate of Airspace Policy (DAP) considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of displays for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
