ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A5 Trunk Road (Tamworth, Staffordshire) (Link Road)
(Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *29th March 2011*
Coming into force - - *5th April 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of one of those connecting roads in Tamworth in the County of Staffordshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Tamworth, Staffordshire) (Link Road) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 5th April 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the link road” means the link road connecting the slip roads leading to and from the A5 with the Ventura Park Road/Elmhurst Drive/Bitterscote Drive roundabout junction at Ventura Retail Park from the centrepoint of the A5 overbridge for a distance of 218 metres in a northerly direction;

“the works period” means the period starting at 08:00 hours on Tuesday 12th April 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
