ROAD TRAFFIC

The A13 Trunk Road (A126 Lakeside Junction, Northbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *3rd May 2011*

Coming into force - - *23rd May 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A13 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A13 Trunk Road (A126 Lakeside Junction, Northbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 23rd May 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A13 Trunk Road in the Borough of Thurrock;

“the northbound carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the link road between the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the trunk road and the slip road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at the A126 Lakeside Junction;

“likelihood of danger” means the actions of some road users to the detriment of road safety on the trunk road; and

“the danger period” means the period starting on Monday 23rd May 2011 and ending on 22nd November 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during the danger period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the maintenance, reconstruction or improvement of the trunk road;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
