**The M42 Motorway (Junction 10, Warwickshire) (Temporary
50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *16th May 2011*
Coming into force - - *23rd May 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway (“the M42”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and two of those connecting roads in the County of Warwickshire should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M42 Motorway (Junction 10, Warwickshire) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 23rd May 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this order, no person shall, during the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 27th May 2011 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this order, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on –

(a) the southbound carriageway of the M42 from the centreline of Green Lane overbridge (north of Junction 10) to the centreline of Overwoods Road overbridge (south of Junction 10);

(b) the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 10; and

(c) the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 10.

3. The provisions of article 3 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
