

- (b) the southern side of the A303 situated 660 metres east of the eastern edge of the A360 Long Barrow Roundabout;
- (c) the eastbound carriageway of the A303 situated 1160 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A344;
- (d) the westbound carriageway of the A303 situated 1160 metres east of the centre of its junction with the A344.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 8, no person shall, during the period of danger, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the A303.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stop on the verge at any time.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:

- (i) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) a vehicle being used at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable.

7. The provisions of articles 3 and 5 shall not apply to a vehicle being used for traffic officer purposes or at the direction, or with the permission, of a traffic officer in uniform.

8. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
