ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M60 and M62 Motorways Junction 18 (Simister Island)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *6th July 2011*
Coming into force - - *10th July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 and M62 Motorways, is satisfied that traffic on sections of those motorways in the Borough of Bury in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M60 and M62 Motorways Junction 18 (Simister Island) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 10th July 2011.

2. In this Order;

“the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road” means the last point where the slip road leaves the carriageway of the motorway;

“the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road” means the first point where the slip road joins the carriageway of the motorway;

“works” means loop installation works on the motorway;

“the works period” means a period over one night between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 11 July 2011 and ending on Friday 15 July 2011. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the length of carriageway” means the M60 clockwise/M62 eastbound carriageway at Junction 18 Simister Island from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 18 to the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 18;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
