ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A49 Trunk Road (Leominster to Hope under Dinmore,
Herefordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *30th August 2011*

Coming into force - - *6th September 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road between Leominster and Hope under Dinmore in the District of the County of Herefordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A49 Trunk Road (Leominster to Hope under Dinmore, Herefordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 6th September 2011.

2. In this Order –

“Marsh roundabout” means the A49/A44 Mill Street roundabout junction near Leominster;

“Marlbrook roundabout” means the A49/B4361 Hereford Road roundabout junction, north of Hope under Dinmore;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 13th September 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave –

- (i) Marsh roundabout at its junction with the A44 Mill Street;
- (ii) Marsh roundabout at its junction with the service station; and

(iii) Marlbrook roundabout at its junction with the B4361 Hereford Road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (iv) proceeding in the A49 to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
