ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Northbound Exit Slip Road Leading to Rob Lane Motorway Depot) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No 2) Order 2011

Made - - - - - *27th September 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *12th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those slip roads in the Borough of St Helens in Merseyside should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Northbound Exit Slip Road Leading to Rob Lane Motorway Depot) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No 2) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12th October 2011.

2. In this Order;

“motorway” means the M6 Motorway;

“the period of prohibition” means a period starting at 0001 hours on Thursday 13 October 2011 and ending when the likelihood of danger to the public has been removed by means other than this Order;

“the slip road” means the exit slip road, situated between Junctions 22 and 23 of the motorway and leading from the northbound carriageway of the motorway to the Rob Lane Motorway Depot.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the period of prohibition, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle authorised to use the slip road, vehicles being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
