ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 23 Spittals Interchange,
Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire) Eastbound Exit Slip Road
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *17th October 2011*
Coming into force - - *24th October 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 23 Spittals Interchange, Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire) Eastbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 24th October 2011.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the eastbound exit slip road of the A14 at Junction 23 Spittals Interchange, during a period of 8 ½ hours starting at 21.00 hours on Wednesday 26th October 2011, or on any subsequent day until pothole repair, crack sealing, drainage and soft estate works, grass cutting, weed spraying and barrier and lighting repairs to the above mentioned slip road have been completed.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicles being used for, or in connection with, the works or for winter service maintenance, police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes.
