**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A27 Trunk Road (Cop Hall Roundabout, Dedicated Link Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *12th December 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - - - - *28th January 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Cop Hall Roundabout, Dedicated Link Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 28th January 2012 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road near Eastbourne in the County of East Sussex;

“the link road” means the dedicated road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A22 to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road at Cop Hall roundabout near Polegate;

“works” mean cyclic maintenance and/or urgent repair work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 9 hours starting at 2000 hours on Saturday 28th January 2012 or on any subsequent day until Sunday 27th January 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
