**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (South of Coventry) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *5th December 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *12th December 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road South of Coventry in the County of Warwickshire should be prohibited and restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (South of Coventry) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12th December 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A45 from its roundabout junction with the A445 Leamington Road and Wolston Lane, at Ryton-on-Dunsmore, to its roundabout junction with the A46 and B4110 London Road (Tollbar End Roundabout);

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 19 December 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the trunk road.

5. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

(a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and

(b) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and

(c) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
