ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A13 Trunk Road (North Stifford and M25 Junction 30)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - 7th February 2011

Coming into force - - 26th February 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A13 Trunk Road is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A13 Trunk Road (North Stifford and M25 Junction 30) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 26th February 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A13 Trunk Road in the Borough of Thurrock;

“a length of carriageway” means –

- (i) the westbound carriageway of the trunk road between the ‘off’ slip road (at marker post 108.3) and the ‘on’ slip road (at marker post 107.4) at the A1012 junction at North Stifford, or
- (ii) the westbound carriageway of the trunk road between the ‘off’ slip road (at marker post 105.1) and the ‘on’ slip road (at marker post 104.0) at M25 Junction 30;

“works” mean resurfacing, retexturing, road marking and road stud installation work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 7 hours starting at 2200 hours on Tuesday 1st March 2011 or on any subsequent day until 25th August 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
