ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Stretton, Rutland) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *11th February 2011*

Coming into force - - *18th February 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”), and connecting roads is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads at Stretton in the District of the County of Rutland should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Stretton, Rutland) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 18th February 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A1 from its roundabout junction with the B668 and Clipsham Road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 0900 hours on Monday 21st February 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the slip road at its junctions with Spinney Lane and Rookery Lane.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (iv) proceeding on the slip road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
