**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A2 Trunk Road (Brenley Corner - Coldred) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *21st February 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *12th March 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on lengths of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (Brenley Corner - Coldred) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 12th March 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A2 Trunk Road in the County of Kent;

“the length of coastbound carriageway” means coastbound carriageway of the trunk road between Brenley Corner (M2 Junction 7) and Canterbury Road overbridge at Boughton Street;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between its junction with Lydden Hill and its junction with Church Road at Coldred;

“works” mean access construction work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 14th March 2011 or on any subsequent day until 11th September 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

- (a) 50 miles per hour on the length of coastbound carriageway; or
- (b) 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
