**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A31 Trunk Road (Bere Regis Roundabout – Roundhouse Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - - *10th January 2011*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *29th January 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A31 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A31 Trunk Road (Bere Regis Roundabout – Roundhouse Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 29th January 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A31 Trunk Road in the County of Dorset;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between Bere Regis roundabout (A35) and Roundhouse roundabout (A350);

“a side road” means any road leading to or from the length of trunk road between Bere Regis roundabout (A35) and Roundhouse roundabout (A350);

“works” mean inlay, patching, whitelining, catseye replacement, kerbing, drainage, sign works, survey works, vegetation clearing, cable repairs and all associated works including public utilities work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 31st January 2011 or on any subsequent day other than a Saturday or Sunday until 27th July 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle –

(a) to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road; or

(b) to enter the length of trunk road from a side road or to enter a side road from the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

(a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;

- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road or a side road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, the length of trunk road to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
