ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A38 and A5148 Trunk Roads (Swinfen to Streethay,
Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *7th May 2012*
Coming into force - - *14th May 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), the A5148 Trunk Road (“the A5148”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of those roads and two of those connecting roads, between Swinfen and Streethay in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 and A5148 Trunk Roads (Swinfen to Streethay, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 14th May 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means –

- i) the northbound carriageway of the A5148 from its junction with slip road leading to the roundabout junction with the A5206 and A38 to its junction with the A38; and
- ii) the northbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with that A5148 to its junction with the A5127 at Streethay;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading –

- i) to the northbound carriageway of the A38 from its roundabout junction with the A5206 (London Road); and
- ii) from the northbound carriageway of the A38 to the A5192 (Cappers Lane);

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 21st May 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
