**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M11 Motorway (Junction 12, Cambridgeshire) Slip Roads  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *28th May 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *4th June 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M11 Motorway (“the M11”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M11 Motorway (Junction 12, Cambridgeshire) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 4th June 2012.

2. In this Order –

“works” mean carriageway resurfacing and repair works, renewal of road markings, installation of loops and antiskid surfacing and grass cutting;

“a first works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 11th June 2012 or on any subsequent day until the works to the first slip road have been completed;

“a second works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Wednesday 13th June 2012 or on any subsequent day until the works to the second slip road have been completed;

“a third works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 18th June 2012 or on any subsequent day until the works to the third slip road have been completed;

“the first slip road” means the M11 Junction 12 southbound exit slip road;

“the second slip road” means the M11 Junction 12 northbound entry slip road;

“the third slip road” means the M11 Junction 12 southbound entry slip road;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first slip road during a first works period, the second slip road during a second works period or the third slip road during a third works period.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes.
