ROAD TRAFFIC

The M60 Motorway (Junction 3 Anticlockwise and Clockwise Exit Slip Roads to the A34 Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 29th May 2012

Coming into force - - 6th June 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M60 Motorway and its slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those slip roads in the District of Stockport in Greater Manchester should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M60 Motorway (Junction 3 Anticlockwise and Clockwise Exit Slip Roads to the A34 Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 6th June 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M60 Motorway;

“the first slip road” means the slip road leading from the anticlockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 3 to the A34 southbound;

“the second slip road” means the slip road leading from the clockwise carriageway of the motorway at Junction 3 to the A34 southbound;

“works” means road widening and traffic signal installation works on the first and second slip roads;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2100 hours and 0500 hours (continuing to 0700 hours on Saturday and Sunday mornings) during a period starting on Thursday 7 June 2012 and ending on Friday 5 October 2012. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such further period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first or second slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
