**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A30 Trunk Road (Temple, Near Bodmin) (Temporary  
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - - *3rd July 2012*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *11th July 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road near Bodmin in Cornwall should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Temple, Near Bodmin) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 11th July 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the A30” means (i) the A30 westbound near Temple from a point 370 metres west of the centre of the Pounds Conce Junction to a point 440 metres west of the centre of the Cardinham Airfield Junction; and (ii) the A30 eastbound near Temple from a point 420 metres east of the centre of the Cardinham Airfield Junction to a point 650 metres east of the centre of that junction;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works” mean routine survey works;

“the works period” means the period starting at 05.00 hours on Friday 13th July 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4, 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period:

- (a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the A30;

(b) cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the layby adjacent to the A30 westbound situated 260 metres west of the centre of the Cardinham Airfield Junction.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

5. The provisions of article 3(b) shall not apply to a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works or for traffic officer purposes.

6. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
