The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Lee Valley White Water Centre, Broxbourne, Hertfordshire) (Amendment) Regulations 2012

Made - - - - - *11th July 2012*

Coming into force - - - - - *12th July 2012*

The Secretary of State has deemed it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of the area specified in regulation 3(1) of the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Lee Valley White Water Centre, Broxbourne, Hertfordshire) Regulations 2012(a) (“the principal Regulations”), by reason of the intended holding of certain London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games’ events that are scheduled to take place there during the period beginning on 29th July 2012 and ending on 2nd August 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(b).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Lee Valley White Water Centre, Broxbourne, Hertfordshire) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 12th July 2012.

Amendment of Regulations

- 2.—(1) The principal Regulations are amended as follows.
- (2) At the end of regulation 3(2)(a), add “or the Chief Constable of Essex Police.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Lee Valley White Water Centre, Broxbourne, Hertfordshire) Regulations 2012 (S.I. 2012/1339) (“the principal Regulations”). The effect of the amendment is to extend an exception to the flying restrictions imposed by the principal Regulations in relation to the Lee Valley White Water Centre to aircraft flying in the service of the Chief Constable of Essex Police.

Full details of the restricted airspace will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
