ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 23 Spittals Interchange,
Cambridgeshire) Eastbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *14th August 2012*
Coming into force - - *21st August 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 23 Spittals Interchange, Cambridgeshire) Eastbound Exit Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 21st August 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 8½ hours starting at 21:00 hours on Tuesday 28th August 2012, or on any subsequent day until sign installation and road marking, drainage, verge, barrier and lighting maintenance and grass cutting and weed spraying works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the eastbound exit slip road of the A14 leading to Junction 23 Spittals Interchange.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes.
