ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A14 Trunk Road (Brington Overbridge, Junction 16
Catworth, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)
Order 2012**

Made - - - - *3rd September 2012*

Coming into force - - *10th September 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Brington Overbridge, Junction 16 Catworth, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 10th September 2012.

2. In this Order –

“a slip road” means the A14 Junction 16 Catworth -

(a) eastbound exit slip road, and

(b) westbound entry slip road;

“works” mean principal inspection works to Brington overbridge;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Thursday 13th September 2012 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle –

(a) being used in connection with the works or for traffic officer purposes,

(b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1 (1) and Schedule 1.

(c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.
