**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M42 Motorway (Junction 4) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - 23rd January 2012

*Coming into force* - - 30th January 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway ("the M42") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on three of those connecting roads in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The M42 Motorway (Junction 4) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 30th January 2012.

2. In this Order -

"a slip road"	means the slip road leading –
	i) from the northbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 4; and
	ii) to the northbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 4;
	iii) to the southbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 4;

"the works period"	means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Thursday 2nd February 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
