**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A3(M) Motorway (Junctions 1 – 2, Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *10th December 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *5th January 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3(M) Motorway, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited a length of that motorway because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3(M) Motorway (Junctions 1 – 2, Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 5th January 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the A3(M) Motorway in the County of Hampshire;

“the length of southbound carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the motorway between its junction with the A3 at Junction 1 and Junction 2 (B2149) near Horndean;

“works” mean bridge deck inlay, road marking, road stud renewal, carriageway repairs, bridge deck expansion joint replacement and all associated work on the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 7th January 2013 or on any subsequent day until 4th July 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of southbound carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
