**The A585 Trunk Road (Fleetwood Road Northbound
Carriageway and Cycle Track)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Cyclists) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *10th December 2012*

Coming into force - - *12th December 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A585 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on a section of that trunk road and cyclists using a section of a cycle track adjacent to that trunk road in the District of Fylde in the County of Lancashire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A585 Trunk Road (Fleetwood Road Northbound Carriageway and Cycle Track) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Cyclists) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 12th December 2012.

2. In this Order;

“the trunk road” means the A585 Trunk Road;

“the length of carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the trunk road from the point where the trunk road meets the circulatory carriageway of the M55 Motorway Junction 3 roundabout to a point 260 metres north of the same point;

“the cycle track” means the cycle track adjacent to the length of carriageway;

“the works” means resurfacing work on the trunk road;

“the works period” means a period over three nights between 2000 hours and 0600 hours starting on Thursday 13 December 2012 and ending on Sunday 16 December 2012. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“cycle track” means a way constituting or comprised in a highway being a way over which the public have a right of way on a bicycle.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.
4. Subject as mentioned in article 5 of this Order, during the works period, no cyclist shall enter or proceed in the cycle track.
5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
