ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A1 Trunk Road (Gonerby Moor, Lincolnshire) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *6th February 2012*

Coming into force - - *13th February 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road (“the A1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two lengths of that trunk road and one of those connecting roads north of Grantham in the County of Lincolnshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Gonerby Moor, Lincolnshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 13th February 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A1 from a point 1000 metres south of its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction with the B1174 to a point 2000 metres north of the centre point of the overbridge at the B1174/Gonerby Lane junction at Gonerby Moor;

“the second length of trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A1 from its junction with the slip road leading to the roundabout junction with the B1174 to a point 1700 metres north of the centre point of the overbridge at the B1174/Gonerby Lane junction at Gonerby Moor;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A1 from its roundabout junction with the B1174/Gonerby lane;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type

shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Sunday 19th February 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the second length of trunk road or the slip road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the A1 1100 metres north of the centre point of the overbridge at the B1174/Gonerby Lane junction at Gonerby Moor.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4, and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of –

- a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- b) articles 3, 4, and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- c) articles 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works; and
- d) article 5 shall not apply to any vehicle proceeding in the second length of trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that length of road.
