**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A14 and A428 Trunk Roads (Junction 31 Girton Interchange, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *20th February 2012*

*Coming into force* - - *27th February 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads and the A428 Trunk Road (“the A428”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of those roads and on one of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 and A428 Trunk Roads (Junction 31 Girton Interchange, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 27th February 2012.

2. In this Order –

“Junction 31” means the M11/A14/A428 Girton Interchange Junction 31”

“the eastbound Clover Leaf” means the A14 Junction 31 eastbound link road from the A14/M11 north-westbound carriageway to the A428/A14 eastbound carriageway (known locally as the eastbound Clover Leaf);

“the trunk road” means the eastbound carriageway of the A428 at Junction 31 from its junction with the eastbound Clover Leaf to its merge with the eastbound carriageway of the A14;

“works” mean repairs to a safety barrier;

“a works period” means a period of 7 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Thursday 1st March 2012 or on any subsequent day (other than a Saturday or Sunday) until the works have been completed

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the eastbound Clover Leaf or the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the works, for winter service maintenance or traffic officer purposes, or for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes.
