ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M27 Motorway (Junction 1, Westbound Exit Slip Road)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *8th April 2013*

Coming into force - - *1st May 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M27 Motorway and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M27 Motorway (Junction 1, Westbound Exit Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 1st May 2013 and shall apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M27 Motorway in the County of Hampshire;

“the slip road” means the road leading from the westbound carriageway of the motorway to the A31 and the B3079 at Junction 1 at Cadnam Interchange;

“works” mean carriageway repairs and all associated work on the motorway; and

“a works period” means a period of 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Wednesday 1st May 2013 or on any subsequent day until Wednesday 30th April 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
