**The A303 Trunk Road (Wincanton Junction Slip Roads)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013**

<i>Made</i> - - - -	<i>14th May 2013</i>
<i>Coming into force</i> - -	<i>18th May 2013</i>

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A303 Trunk Road (“the A303”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads at Wincanton in the District of South Somerset in the County of Somerset should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A303 Trunk Road (Wincanton Junction Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 18th May 2013 and apply for a period of twelve months.

2. In this Order –

“the slip roads” mean the westbound exit slip road and eastbound entry slip road at the A303 Wincanton Junction;

“the works” mean grass cutting, litter picking, gully cleaning, barrier re-tensioning, road sweeping, studs and patching, road markings and general maintenance works;

“a works period” means a period of 8½ hours starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 20th May 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.
