ROAD TRAFFIC

The M1 Motorway (Barlborough, Derbyshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - *15th July 2013*

Coming into force - - *22nd July 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and two of those connecting roads, near Barlborough in the County of Derbyshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Barlborough, Derbyshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 22nd July 2013.

2. In this Order –

| “the motorway” | means –
i) the southbound carriageway of the M1 from a point 1330 metres south of the centreline of the A618 Mansfield Road / Rotherham Road overbridge to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 30; and
ii) the northbound carriageway of the M1 from the centreline of the bridge over the disused Oxcroft Junction to Clowne railway to its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 30; |
| “a slip road” | means the slip road –
i) leading from the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 30; and
ii) leading to the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 30; |
| "the works period" | means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 29th July 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed; |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;

b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -

(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or

(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or a traffic officer in uniform; and

c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
