**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A45 Trunk Road (Brackmills, Northampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *24th July 2013*  
*Coming into force* - - *31st July 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A45 Trunk Road (“the A45”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road and one of those connecting roads, at Brackmills, Northampton, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A45 Trunk Road (Brackmills, Northampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 31st July 2013.

2. In this Order:

| “Barns Meadow Interchange” | means the junction of the A45/A428 and A5095 Rushmere Road near Brackmills;  |
| “the trunk road”           | means the westbound carriageway of the A45 from its junction with the slip road leading to Barns Meadow Interchange to its junction with the slip road leading from the roundabout junction with Caswell Road; |
| “the slip road”            | means the slip road leading to the westbound carriageway of the A45 from Barns Meadow Interchange;   |
| “the works period”         | means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Wednesday 7th August 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;  |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
