ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 43 to Junction 41) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - *1st August 2013*

Coming into force - - *9th August 2013*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and connecting roads, in the Counties of West Yorkshire and North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because abnormal load lift works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 43 to Junction 41) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 9th August 2013.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 11 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 10th August 2013 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the:

- (i) A1(M) Motorway southbound carriageway from the nose of the southbound exit slip road at Junction 43 (Hook Moor) to the nose of the southbound entry slip road at Junction 41 (Holmfield), a distance of 14700 metres;
- (ii) A1(M) Motorway southbound exit and entry slip roads at Junction 42 (Selby Fork);
- (iii) link road connecting the A1(M) Motorway southbound carriageway to the M62 Motorway eastbound carriageway at Holmfield Interchange (M62 Motorway Junction 32a and A1(M) Motorway Junction 41);
or
- (iv) link road connecting the A1(M) Motorway southbound carriageway to the M62 Motorway westbound carriageway at Holmfield Interchange (M62 Motorway Junction 32a and A1(M) Motorway Junction 41).

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
