**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A500 Trunk Road (Shelton, Stoke on Trent) (Slip Road)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *13th August 2013*

*Coming into force* - - *20th August 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road (“the A500”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads, in the City of Stoke on Trent, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A500 Trunk Road (Shelton, Stoke on Trent) (Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 20th August 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A500 from the A5006 Stoke Road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 19:00 hours on Tuesday 27th August 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
