ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway and A1 Trunk Road (Redhouse to Barnsdale Bar) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 3rd October 2013

Coming into force - 13th October 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway, the A1 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the Counties of South Yorkshire and West Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and trunk road and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway repair, marking and stud renewal and loop replacement works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway and A1 Trunk Road (Redhouse to Barnsdale Bar) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 13th October 2013.

2. In this Order: -

“the A1(M)” means the A1(M) Motorway;

“the A1” means the A1 Trunk Road;

“the northbound carriageway” means the northbound carriageway of the A1(M) and A1 from the nose of the exit slip road at Redhouse Interchange to the nose of the entry slip road at Barnsdale Bar Interchange, a distance of 4750 metres;

“a slip road” means the:

- (i) A638 Trunk Road northbound entry slip road at Redhouse Interchange from its junction with Wakefield Road to the northbound carriageway, or
- (ii) A1 northbound entry slip road at Redhouse Interchange;

“a layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the A1 over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means a period of:

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

- (i) 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 14th October 2013 or any subsequent Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday night thereafter until the said works have been completed; or
- (ii) 9 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 19th October 2013 or any subsequent Saturday or Sunday night thereafter until the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the northbound carriageway or a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to:

- (i) enter or wait in a layby situated adjacent to the northbound carriageway approximately 1845 metres north of Leys Lane;
- (ii) enter or leave the northbound carriageway at its junctions with Leys Lane and Bannister Lane; or
- (iii) leave the northbound carriageway at its junction with the A639 at Barnsdale Bar Interchange.

5. The provisions articles 3 and 4 of this Order apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for winter maintenance or traffic officer purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to any vehicle proceeding in the A1 to or from premises and property which is accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
