**The A500 Trunk Road (Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire)
(Connecting Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order
2013**

Made - - - - - *28th October 2013*
Coming into force - - - *4th November 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road (“the A500”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads in the City of Stoke-on-Trent, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A500 Trunk Road (Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire) (Connecting Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 4th November 2013.

2. In this Order –

“the first link road” means the link road leading from the A500/A52/A5006 Stoke Road junction to the A500/A52 City Road junction;

“the second link road” means the link road leading from its junction with A500/A52 City Road junction to the A500/A52/A5006 Stoke Road junction;

“a slip road” means –

- i) the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A500 from its junction with the first link road at Glebe Street Bridge; and
- ii) the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A500 from its junction with the

second link road at Glebe Street
Bridge;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 22:00 hours on
Thursday 7th November 2013 and ending
when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first link road, the second link road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
