ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A27 Trunk Road (East of Firle Road Junction)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *11th February 2013*

Coming into force - - *2nd March 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (East of Firle Road Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 2nd March 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road (Lewes Road) in the County of East Sussex;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);

“the A27 lay-by” means the lay-by in the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road 29 metres east of the centre of Firle Road junction;

“works” mean footway renewal work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 13 hours starting at 1900 hours on Monday 4th March 2013 or on any subsequent day until 1st September 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in, or wait on, the A27 lay-by.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
